More than 20 different sports being contested during June and July in the 2010 Aloha State Games — Hawaii's Olympics for the common person. The 2010 Aloha State Games FENCING tournament is open to all foil, sabre and epee enthusiasts. Hosted by Hawaii Fencing Club, at the Ala Wai Clubhouse ballroom.

ALOHA STATE GAMES ENTRY FEE – The entry fee of \$20 per person is designed to cover costs of conducting the competition, including awards and insurance. Children under 12 as of June 1 may enter for \$15.

T-SHIRTS – All persons registering before the **June 1 deadline** will receive a T-shirt. Every effort will be made to supply T-shirts in the size noted on the entry forms; if this size is NOT available, then the next available size will be substituted. **Participants registering after June 1 WILL NOT** receive a T-shirt unless they pay the late penalty (\$5 per person). All T-shirts will be delivered to the tournament venue.

Format: Electric foil, epee, and sabre; men and women will fence together in each category, although results will be posted separately.
Requirements: Fencers must be members of the US Fencing Association (junior and “fence for fun” members welcome); USFA membership application available at venue or in advance from commissioner. Uniforms must meet USFA safety requirements and weapons must pass USFA compliance tests.
Register info: DEADLINE June 1; late registration and walk-up entries accepted until competition begins; fencers may not enter two overlapping categories at same time.
Register Fee: \$20 per person (\$15 for children under 12 as of June 1); entries received (postmarked) after the deadline will not receive a T-shirt without payment of a \$10 late penalty.
