More than 20 different sports being contested during June and July in the 2010 Aloha State Games — Hawaii's Olympics for the common person. The 2010 Aloha State Games Table Tennis Tournament is sanctioned by USATT, and is open to all ping pong enthusiasts. Dates are June 11 & 12; venue is Palama's Weinberg Gym, located at 810 N. Vineyard Blvd.

**ALOHA STATE GAMES ENTRY FEE** – The entry fee of \$35 per person includes three events; participants may enter a fourth event for an additional \$5. Children under 12 as of June 1 may enter for \$20.

**T-SHIRTS** – All persons registering before the June 2 deadline will receive a T-shirt. Every effort will be made to supply T-shirts in the size noted on the entry forms; if this size is NOT available, then the next available size will be substituted. Entries will NOT be accepted after the June 2 deadline. T-shirts will be delivered to the tournament venue.

Format: All events begin with round-robin play, then proceed to single elimination; all matches best-of-five (except Elite singles medal rounds which will be best-of-seven – games following new 11-point format). Events with fewer than four players will be canceled or combined with other events (if your event is scratched, you can select another). All age brackets are co-ed. Players must check in at least 15 minutes before scheduled starting time of their event (failure to do so will result in forfeiture); participants may enter a maximum of three events for which they are eligible; to enter rated event, must have current and appropriate HTTC or USATT rating; age eligibility as of June 1, 2010; tournament rules and regulations follow USATT and HTTC practices.

Divisions:\* Juniors (under 18); Veteran (40+); Seniors (60+); Unrated Open; Rated Under 1100; Rated under 1300; Rated under 1500; Rated under 1700; Rated under 1900; Elite (minimum rating 1700);

Category: Doubles
Divisions:\* Rated under 2500 (highest rated player must be under 1400); Rated under 3100 (highest rated player must be under 1700); Open

\*All age brackets/divisions are co-ed.

Event Support provided by PADDLE PALACE

Requirements: Rackets must meet USATT standards; shirts, shoes and dark colored clothing preferred (shoes must be soft-soled, non black to protect the floor); participants must follow posted gym rules.

Eligibility: It is voluntary to play using USATT ratings and have the results count for your USATT rating. If you wish to play as a USATT-rated player with results counted and being sent to the USATT, you must either be a current member of the USATT, join the USATT or buy the once per lifetime tournament pass, and also pay the \$7 USATT Rating Fee. Unrated players may play in any event but will ONLY advance in the Open events.

Register Info: DEADLINE JUNE 2; no late or walk-up entries. For doubles, add partner's name on your form; partner must register separately.

Register Fee: \$35 per person for three events; fourth event can be added for an additional \$5 – \$20 for children under 12 as of June 1, 2010. Entry fee includes \$15 facilities fee.
